Bouree en Trois Temps

Source: There are many variations to the "bourree", but this is a bourree as presented by Suzy Davoust, at Evansville International Folk Dancers. *Formation:* Two couples in a square with partner across from each other, L shoulder into the centre.

- Count PART A Pas de bourree
 - Couple #1 starts, as they go out, couple #2 goes in
 - 1 Step L to the L
 - 2 R together
 - 3 Step L to the L
 - & Hop on L and turn 1/2 to L
 - 4 Step R
 - 5 Step L together
 - 6 Step R to R
 - & Hop R

Couple #1 REPEAT Pas de bourree to return to original place (couple #2 starts)

DANCE PART A 4 TIMES

PART B

Couple 1 turns 1/4 L while advancing w/a L, R-together, L They pass in the centre, facing each other with a R, L-together, R (1/3 turn to R)

They back into their partner's place w/a complete pas de bourree, finishing w/L shoulder in, as couple #2 begins part B
