Source: Learned from Yves Moreau, fall 1969, at local festival in Novo Selo, Vidin District - NW Bulgaria. It is widespread in the vicinity of Bregovo near the border of Serbia. It is of the "Cacak" types, with a ten-measure pattern. Bregovsko is danced by Bulgarians and Vlachs living in the area. Meter: 4/4 Notation: Yves Moreau Formation: Short mixed lines of M & W. Belt-hold, L over R. Face center w/weight on L. Style: Small steps, sharp movements. Knees slightly bent. Arms relaxed. Often, the dancers at both ends of the line, make the line bend and twist sharply (na dva tanca). Introduction: Dance may begin at the beginning of any musical phrase.

Measures Count

- 1 Facing center, step R to R
 - 2 Step on L behind R
- 2 1–2 Repeat action of measure 1
- 3 1 Step on R to R
 - 2 Small hop on R bringing L slightly across in front of R
- 4 1 Step on L across in front of R
 - 2 Small hop on L, bringing R foot slightly FWD and across L
- 5 1 Step R across L bending FWD, and face L of center
 - 2 Small hop on R
- 6 1 Step L to L of center
 - 2 Step on R in front of L
- 7 1 Facing center, step on L
 - 2 Small hop on L in place
- 8 1 Small step on R toward center
 - 2 Small hop on R in place
- 9 1 Facing slightly L of center, small step on L to L
 - 2 Step on R across L
- $\begin{array}{ccc} 10 & & 1 & & \text{Facing center, small \mathfrak{s}tep on L to L,} \\ & & \text{bending upper part of body slightly} \end{array}$
 - 2 Small sharp stamp w/R next to L, no weight
