

Duke of Kent's Waltz

Origin: From 1802 *Formation:* Colonial dance, much like a Contra dance. Done in a proper longways set. Take hands four from the top. 1, 3, 5, etc. active. Do not cross over.

Measure

- 1-4 Star by the R (active couple with couple below)

- 1-4 Start by the L

- 1-4 Active, 2-hands across, slip down for 2 measures and back to place (step on counts 1 and 3)

- 1-4 Actives cast down; inactives move up

- 1-4 All give R hands to partner; balance FWD and BKWD; exchange places, W turning under raised arms

- 1-4 REPEAT above giving L hands

- 1-4 Turn by the R w/corner

- 1-4 Turn by the L w/partner
