	All tap foot 4 times in rhythm with the music
5-6	"Back right out to the corner maid"
	All back out 4 steps from the center and
	turn to face corner
7–8	"Swing her once and promenade"
	Swing corner with a two-hand swing
9–16	Promenade 16 counts to music,
	then face the center ready to begin again.
