

# Irish Washerwoman

Type: American Irish Mixer      Rhythm: 6/8, 2 strong counts per measures

Formation: Partners in single circle, hands joined, facing center, W on M's R

---

Measure

1-2      *"Ob, we'll all join hands and go to the middle"*

All walk 4 steps into the center of the circle

3-4      *"And tap our feet to the tune of the fiddle"*

All tap foot 4 times in rhythm with the music

5-6      *"Back right out to the corner maid"*

All back out 4 steps from the center and  
turn to face corner

7-8      *"Swing her once and promenade"*

Swing corner with a two-hand swing

9-16      Promenade 16 counts to music,

then face the center ready to begin again.
