Source: Livan Oy (Lee-one Ooy) is a folk song from Tunceli and the steps are typical from the region and could be done with other songs also. Livan is the name of a girl.

Meter: 6/4 and 4/4

Formation: Semi-circle, little fingers hold in W position.

Introduction: 4 times of 6/4 measure

<u>Counts</u>	<u>FIG. 1</u> - arms up W position, little fingers hold, bounce arms
1	Step on R to R
2	Step on L to R, crossing R
3	Step on R to R
4	Touch L in place next to R, bounce from knees
5	Step on L to L
6	Touch R in place next to L

	<u>FIG. 2</u> - arms down, V position
1, &	Face LOD and step on R FWD; Bring L next to R moving LOD
2	Step on R FWD
3, &	Step FWD on L; Bring R next to L moving LOD
4	Step FWD on L
5	Step on R w/turning toward centre, and bounce on knees
6	2 quick and soft bounces on both feet
7	Step on L to L, facing centre
8	Touch R heel in place, facing centre
