*Source*: Livan Oy (Lee-one Ooy) is a folk song from Tunceli and the steps are typical from the region and could be done with other songs also. Livan is the name of a girl.

*Meter:* 6/4 and 4/4 *Formation:* Semi-circle, little fingers hold in W position.

*Introduction:* 4 times of 6/4 measure

- <u>Counts</u> <u>FIG. 1</u> arms up W position, little fingers hold, bounce arms
  - 1 Step on R to R
  - 2 Step on L to R, crossing R
  - 3 Step on R to R
  - 4 Touch L in place next to R, bounce from knees
  - 5 Step on L to L
  - 6 Touch R in place next to L
    - FIG. 2 arms down, V position
  - 1, & Face LOD and step on R FWD; Bring L next to R moving LOD
  - 2 Step on R FWD
  - 3, & Step FWD on L; Bring R next to L moving LOD
  - 4 Step FWD on L
  - 5 Step on R w/turning toward centre, and bounce on knees
  - 6 2 quick and soft bounces on both feet
  - 7 Step on L to L, facing centre
  - 8 Touch R heel in place, facing centre
