Source: Pascovia, also called Pelouere, comes from Haute Bretagne (high Brittany)

Formation: Couples in a line, promenade position. The women on the R of the man, all facing CCW

around the room. Must be an even number of couples.

<u>Counts</u>	<u>Part A</u>
1, 2	All touch the L heel to the L. Touch the L toe in front of the R.
3, &, 4	Dance FWD to the L, R together, L
5-8	REPEAT to the R
	(Sometimes this step is repeated, sometimes not. It depends on the tune)
	Part B
1-7	Dance to the left (L, R, L, R, L, R, L)
8-16	Dance to the right (R, L, R, L, R, L, R)
	Part C - Bows and Stars
1	Face partner, holding R hands and bow
2-4	M pulls W under his R arm, turning her CCW to form a RH star w/the next couple in the line.
1-3	Turn the star
4	Clap (kill the flies)
1-3	Form a LH star, holding your partner's L hand, turn the star
4	Release hands w/the other couple and bow to partner, L hands joined
1-4	M pulls partner CW under his L arm to take promenade position

And the dance starts over again!
