

SIRTAKI PO LOVESKI

Origin: This is a 13-measure dance pattern in 2/4 meter. People in Lovech call it Sirtaki. Sirtaki po Loveshki means Sirtaki in Lovech style.

Source: This dance was taught by Yuliyana Yordanova at Autumn Leaves XXII, NIFD, 2005

Formation: It can be done to many different pieces of music in not very long lines, facing center.
Arms are in a shoulder hold

<u>Measures</u>	<u>Counts</u>	
1	1	Step on R to L, crossing in front of L
	2	Step on L to L
2	1-2	SAME as measure 1 (crossing can be done behind instead of in front)
3	1	Step on R to L, crossing in front of L
	2	Pivot on R to R
4	1	Step on L to R, crossing in front of R
	2	Step on R to R
5	1-2	SAME as measure 4 (crossing can be done behind instead of in front)
6	1	Step on L to R, crossing in front of R
	2	Pivot on L to L
7	1	Step on R FWD, crossing in front of L
	2	Bounce on R
8	1	Step on L FWD, crossing in front of R
	2	Bounce on L
9	1	Leap FWD onto R, bending the upper body
	2	Touch behind w/L toes
10	1	Step BACK on L
	2	Kick w/R
11	1	Step BACK on R
	2	Kick w/L
12	1	Step BACK on L
	2	Kick w/R
13	1	Touch w/R heel diagonally FWD to R
	2	Lift R (or bend it back)
