# ZILLERTALER LÄNDLER

*Translated by* : Prof. Karl Horak Steps: Walking (tripping) steps throughout the dance, so there is a continuous flow of movement

Formation: Circle of couples standing side-by-side, facing CCW. Inside hands are joined. M's outside hand is place on braces; W outside hand holds down her skirt.

<u>Counts</u> 1 2 3-4	<u>Introduction</u> Swing joined inside hands FWD Swing them BKWD By swinging FWD W is turned CW, releasing hands
1-8	<u>WOMAN TURNS</u> Inside hands are rejoined and raised. W turns CW in front of M
1-8	<u>SWING ARMS</u> Partners face each other, M facing CCW, W CW. They join both hands (W's R in M's L, W's L in M's R), holding them closed. Swing joined hands alternately into the center (1 count = 3 steps) and out (1 count), progressing CCW.
1-8	<u>RIGHT "YOKE"</u> M facing CCW. He raises L arm under which W turns once CW. W stands now on the R of M, facing CW; M's L hand is put on M's neck, M's R arm extended and put on W's L shoulder. Tripping around.
1-8	<u>LEFT "YOKE"</u> M facing CCW. He raises L arm and under which W turns CCW. The M lowers L arm and raises R arm under which W continues turning CCW. Now W stands on the L of M facing CW. M's R hand is put on M's neck, M's L arm is extended and put on W's R shoulder. Tripping around CCW.
1-8	STEP OVER M facing CCW. He raises R arm under which W turns CW until she faces M. W kneels on her R knee, lowers her R hand and raises L. M steps over the joined lowered hands (R foot 1st). While W rises slowly, M without releasing hands turns L (CCW) in bent over position between the W's open arms, then he places the joined hands on his R hip and continues to turn under the arms. M straightens to upright position and turns W once R (CW).
1-8	LEADING AROUND L They release hands and rejoin them in crossed position, R over L. M keeps R hands high, passing them over his head as he leads W CCW around behind him to his R side. The joined L hands are placed on the M's L hip. Keeping the joined R hands FWD at chest level, they turn L (CCW). (continued on next page)

#### LEADING AROUND R

1-8 M leads W behind him from his R side to his L so that their L hands are kept FWD and joined R hands are placed on M's R hip. They turn R (CW).

#### <u>RIGHT "WINDOW"</u>

1-8 M facing CCW. He bends BKWD under the W's R arm. Keeping high joined hands held together, W turns once and 3/4 to R (CW) as M turns 1/4 to L (CCW) so that R hips are adjacent and R upper-arms are held together. Joined L hands are lowered to rest on the R upper-arms. They turn CW looking through the "window."

#### LEFT "WINDOW"

1-8 They raise joined hands. W turns CCW two and 1/2 times and M turns 1/2 times CW. L hips and L upper-arms are adjacent, as joined R hands are lowered to rest on the L upper-arms. Turning CCW looking through the "window."

#### WALTZ AND FINALE

1-8 They raise joined hands. W turns once R (CW). Drop released L hands. W turns once more R under the raised R hands. They drop R hands and rejoin hands in ballroom position. Laendler-Waltz (w/tripping steps) turning CW and progressing CCW. Finally M lifts W high.
